Pentecost -God shows up...again!

Hello Everyone!



Today is Pentecost Sunday-a watershed moment in the life of the early church. God, The Holy Spirit “showed up.” What this meant was that a group of previously frightened, fledgling people, received transforming power to carry the Word of God to ends of the earth as Apostles.

In the Acts of the Apostles account, the apostles went out into Jerusalem prophesying and speaking in languages that all the visitors to Jerusalem could understand ("God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven... each one heard them speaking in his own language.")

In his book *Discipleship*, author and evangelist, David Watson reflects on the influence and power of the Holy Spirit in the lives of the Apostles. He writes: “When the Spirit came upon them at Pentecost, nothing could stop them. Despite threats, imprisonments, beatings, and killings, their enraged opponents had to acknowledge that these ordinary men and women had turned the world upside down...Devoid of human resources, they were totally dependent on the Spirit of God.” Watson, *Discipleship*, pp. 96.

Watson challenges the church to call upon, and to be led by the Holy Spirit -as all too often, the church has been more affected by the peril and ways of the world. Therefore, as a response, the people of God must be dedicated to the discipline of prayer -calling upon the Holy Spirit of God to empower and encourage us in our faith and work together.

On Pentecost - birthday of the church, let us re-dedicate ourselves to being guided by the Holy Spirit. You can be sure that this same Holy Spirit, who energized and guided the Apostles, the Holy Spirit Whom we profess faith in (in the Creed), will fill us and empower us in the very same way today. Do you allow the power of God to impact your life? Do you wonder what that might look like? It is exciting to ponder this. May the power of God in-fill us all, as we continue to seek His face here and now.
